Notice of Availability of a Final Environmental Impact Statement for the Enbridge Line 5 Tunnel Project, Emmet and Mackinac Counties, Michigan

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: The Detroit District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) has published a Notice of Availability in the Federal Register to notify the public that a Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) has been prepared and is available for review and comment.

APPLICANT: Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership

LOCATION OF WORK: Straits of Mackinac (Lake Michigan), between Point LaBarbe, St. Ignace, Mackinac County, and McGulpin Point, Mackinaw City, Emmet County, Michigan.

APPLICANT'S PROPOSED PROJECT: The applicant proposes to bore a 21-foot-diameter, 3.6-mile-long tunnel underneath the bed of the Straits of Mackinac to house a 30-inch-diameter pipeline for crude oil and natural gas liquids. The proposed pipeline segment within the tunnel would replace the existing two 20-inch-diameter pipelines buried close to shore and resting or supported on the lakebed at greater depths. FINAL EIS: The Notice of Availability for the Final EIS was published in the Federal Register on February 6, 2026. The Final EIS is available for public review beginning on February 6, 2026, on the project website at www.line5tunneleis.com. The Final EIS addresses the potential environmental impacts of the proposed project and reasonable alternatives to the project. The Final EIS will inform USACE's Record of Decision and permit decision on the application, which will be completed no sooner than 30 days after Final EIS publication.
