Charleston District Regulatory Program Modernization

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: The Charleston District, South Atlantic Division, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), is transitioning to a new method for receiving electronic regulatory submittals and updating its District websites.

Effective December 5, 2025, the Charleston District will no longer accept electronic requests submitted by email. All electronic submittals should be made through the Regulatory Request System (RRS) at <https://rrs.usace.army.mil>

The RRS is a secure, web-based platform designed to provide a consistent application experience across the USACE Regulatory Program, streamline data collection, and improve customer service and response times. The system allows users to submit requests, upload supporting documentation, comment on public notices, report potential violations, and track the status of their projects in one centralized location.

As part of this transition, the South Atlantic Division is also updating all District websites to **remove content available in the RRS and focus on state and District specific information**. All Division websites will feature a **consistent look and feel across all District/state pages** and will direct users to the RRS as the exclusive means for electronic submissions.

This transition supports USACE's ongoing efforts to modernize regulatory processes, reduce processing delays, eliminate paper-based processes, and improve transparency.
